

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This MoU is made on 12th June, 2025 between
The Punjab Emergency Service Department (Rescue 1122), Rajanpur
And Indus Consortium

This MoU is signed under the **Strengthening Health Systems and Women's Roles in Climate Adaptation Project (District Rajanpur - Punjab)**, this initiative is supported by **Foundation S**.

The Punjab Emergency Service Department (Rescue 1122) is established in accordance with the Punjab Emergency Service Act of 2006. Its purpose is to ensure the provision of timely emergency care to victims of any kind of emergencies and flood-affected individuals without discrimination, as well as to enhance the capacity building of other emergency-related organizations in Punjab.

Indus Consortium for Humanitarian, Environment, and Development Initiative is an umbrella of 64 civil society organizations in Pakistan and is registered with the Securities Exchange Commission of Pakistan (SECP) under section 42 of the companies' ordinance of Pakistan. Indus Consortium is a certified member of the Pakistan Centre for Philanthropy (PCP), registered as tax Payer Company with FBR with NPO status, and has an MOU with the Economic Affairs Division of Pakistan (EAD) to be an eligible, not-for-profit organization to receive foreign funding for ongoing Projects and Program. Indus Consortium is implementing the project titled "Strengthening Health Systems and Women's Roles in Climate Adaptation in District Rajanpur". This project aims to build the resilience of local communities against the impacts of climate change, with a special focus on strengthening the health system and empowering women and vulnerable groups through inclusive and integrated health interventions.

Both the organizations have reached the following understanding and agreed on the following terms and conditions of coordination and cooperation, for the **Strengthening Health Systems and Women's Roles in Climate Adaptation in District Rajanpur Project**:

Terms and Conditions:

1. This MoU is non-binding but the understanding of mutual support, coordination and cooperation to work together for the capacity building of **Community Volunteers** in District Rajanpur.
2. Both the organizations will collaborate on the capacity building of community volunteers on Basic Life Skills – First Aid - flood preparedness and health response in District Rajanpur.



3. Indus Consortium will support Rescue 1122 for the capacity building of the local communities of disaster prone areas especially the flood prone areas in Rajanpur in preparedness to better health response in floods time.
4. Indus Consortium will also develop and print the data base of the trainees in shape of a directory.
5. Rescue-1122 will arrange capacity building trainings of 10 Community Groups consisting Men / Women to better health response to disasters or emergencies especially the climatic emergencies like River Flood or Flash Floods with the support of Indus Consortium.
6. Indus Consortium will provide First Aid Kits to the trained local community volunteers as proposed by the Rescue 1122.
7. Indus Consortium along with the provision of First Aid Kits; will provide the remuneration for Local Travelling and Food to the training participants and the honorarium to the trainer & supervisor of the training (Training Resource persons of Rescue 1122) as token of appreciation.


This MoU is got effective upon the date of its signing by both the parties and shall remain effective for a period of two (2) years. Either party may terminate this MoU by providing written notice to the other party thirty (30) days prior to the intended termination date.
